- Ride through Cappadocia with a nostalgic electric trike along a guided route
- Visit Çavuşin, Paşabağ and Zelve Valley with short stops for photos
- Easy and safe experience with no prior driving experience required

A relaxed and easy-paced way to explore Cappadocia, this tour offers a guided ride with electric nostalgic trike vehicles along a fixed route. The experience is designed for comfort and simplicity, making it suitable for beginners and those looking for a light outdoor activity without physical effort.

The route begins from Göreme and continues towards Çavuşin, where you can observe traditional rock houses, dovecotes, and an old church located on the hillside.

From there, the tour continues to Paşabağ (Monks Valley), known for its unique fairy chimneys. After a short stop, the route proceeds to Zelve Valley, where layered rock formations and natural structures can be seen.

The experience includes planned stops depending on the selected option. The 1-hour tour includes one photo stop, while the sunset tour includes two photo stops along the route.

The ride is conducted at a controlled speed, allowing guests to follow the guide comfortably and enjoy the surroundings without rushing.
